		0	The Kingdom of (the physical kingdom of Israel and Jesus Christ. It is equated with God's reign through the kings of Israel in the Old Testament and will be restored and ruled forever by the Lord Jesus Christ – 2 Sam. 7). All believers are/will be citizens of this Kingdom.				
		0	Forgiveness - Matt. 18:21-23. (therefore: for this reason. Related to something previously stated). "70x7" = no limit to forgiveness/reconciliation if sought for.				
	• This servant owed his master an <u>unpayable</u> amount and was forgiven – Matt. 18:24-27! But instead of showing his master's forgiveness to others, he revealed his evil heart – Matt. 18:28-30.						
	•	<ul> <li>How can you, who have been forgiven much, not forgive others? – Matt. 18:34-35.</li> </ul>					
		0	The price of unforgiveness: – Matt. 4:24, 8:6; 1 John 4:18; Rev. 9:5.

	•		h – the god of the Ammonites. The worship of this false god, along with offering children as a ce to him, was strictly forbidden and carried a heavy punishment – Lev. 18:21, 20:2-5; Jer. 32:35.				
	•	do not	g, Solomon had special instructions from the Lord: do not return to Egypt nor go there for help, t multiply riches nor horses to yourself, and to not multiply unto himself – Deut. 17:14-lomon violated – 1 Kings 11:1-4.				
	•		it is possible that Solomon directly participated, he was nonetheless before God – s 11:5-11.

		0	Both are Old Testament prophets – 1 Kings 17-22; Matt. 11:9.				
		0	Both with a mission to turn the hearts of the people back to the Lord – 1 Kings 18:37; Luke 1:17.				
		0	Both preparing the way of the Lord − 1 Kings 17:1, 18:1; James 5:17; Matt. 11:10-14; Isaiah 40:3 → John 1:23; Mal. 3:1, 4:5-6 (dual prophesy- Rev. 11:1-14).				
		0	Both fought against – 1 Kings 18:21-40 (Ahab & Jezebel = antichrist & false religion); Matt. 3:7-12.				
	•	John t	he Baptist was NOT a Elijah – Matt. 17:1-13; John 1:21.
