

MISSION HARVEST BAPTIST CHURCH

Mission: Our mission is to glorify God by reconciling, conforming, and perfecting individuals according to the Scriptures.

- **Reconcile** each person to their heavenly Father through His Son by the power of the gospel
- **Conform** the born-again believer into the image of Christ through the word of God
- **Perfect** the disciples of Jesus Christ that they might minister His word to the world

Simply put: build a team of spiritual "Green Berets" who can multiply and get them into the fight.

2 Tim. 2:2-4, 7

"And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

No man that warreth entangleth himself in the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier...

Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things."

Philosophy of Ministry: *train our people to spiritual maturity (2 Pet. 1:5-8) and to live life ready...*

- Ready to fellowship with Jesus Christ, personally

"God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord." (1 Cor. 1:9)

- Ready to follow Christ obediently, walking in the Spirit

"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit." (Gal. 5:25)

- Ready to serve, edifying the Body of Christ

"For he that is called in the Lord, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, being free, is Christ's servant. Ye are bought with a price; be not ye servants of men." (1 Cor. 7:22-23)

Philosophy of Ministry: *train our people to spiritual maturity (2 Pet. 1:5-8) and to live life ready...*

- Ready to go and share the gospel of Jesus Christ

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations..." (Matt. 28:19a)

- Ready to go and make disciples

"Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you..." (Matt. 28:20a)

- Ready to go before the Judgment Seat of Christ

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad."

What is the Plan?

MISSION HARVEST BAPTIST CHURCH

2026:

- Secure a meeting location (likely, Clarksville-Montgomery County Schools)
- Deploy with trained disciple-makers (currently: 12 from GBC, 1 from TN)
- Start simply: meet for Sunday morning main service; meet for prayer Wednesday evenings
- Each disciple-maker finds one new disciple and begins a discipleship relationship (*this has already started for 2 members of the team*)

What is the Plan?

MISSION HARVEST BAPTIST CHURCH

2027: **MULTIPLY!**

- Continue to strengthen the MHBC core of disciple-makers
- Incorporate Sunday school into Sunday mornings and formalize Wednesday evening services and prayer meetings
- Identify opportunities for higher levels of discipleship training (Bible institute)
- Host an MHBC Vacation Bible School (please help us, GBC! 😊)
