Jonah gets a second chance to fulfill the Word of God in His life by going and speaking for God in the most
wicked city on Earth at the time, capital of the Assyrian Empire, Nineveh. Jonah did not like these people for
many reasons. But God gave him the words to speak to them just as He promises to give us the words to
speak when we go anywhere for Him. Sometimes it seems difficult to find the right words in a conversation
with someone about matters. What if we don't speak or respond well? What if we freeze or even
misspeak? How will we know what to say? These are things we will explore today through Jonah's journey.
