AI & Bible Prophecy: Artificial Information from the Enemy

Prophecy - [noun] a prediction, declaration, or piece of information which pronounces something _____ or something yet to come - Rev. 22:7; Gen. 3:15 → Rev. 19:10; 2 Chron. 15:8; Neh. 6:12; Dan. 9:24; Is. 9:6-7.

In scripture, a book of prophecies or a history - 2 Chron. 9:29; Rev. 22:10.

Prophecy - [verb] to predict, declare, or give information about something unknown or yet to come - 1 Kings 22:8; Matt. 11:13; 26:67-68; Num. 11:25; John 11:51; Jude 1:14.

Prophets were given the future truths of God, preached them, and wrote them down as Scripture - 1 Peter 1:10; 2 Pet. 1:19-21. (a prophet prophesies and delivers a prophecy)

KEY: We have a unique view today with so much prophecy that has been fulfilled, mysteries that have been revealed, and even prophecy yet unfulfilled. That being said, it is important to remember that as we look at scripture and _____ applications to AI, it is just that - a possibility. It is still too early to make definitive judgments and that is by God's design! The Bible is the final authority on all matters and God knows every outcome of every possibility. Prophecy belongs exclusively to Him and its purpose is not for us to focus on guessing a *date and time*, but to **have an urgency** to finish the work (John 17:4) because His return is approaching - Mark 13:35!

Satan's 3-fold "Prophecy" of Deception

Genesis 3:1-6

1. Counterfeit Wisdom

- a. It starts with a "baited" question - 3:1.
- b. Satan masterfully tells a "half-truth": "*your eyes shall be opened*" - 3:5.
 - i. Creating _____ - Pro. 14:30, 23:17; James 4:5.
 - ii. Eyes were opened to sin - 3:7, 10; Matt. 6:23.
 - iii. Now our sinful eyes must be opened to God's light - Acts 26:18.
- c. What they became "wise" in was to do evil - Jer. 4:22.
- d. Emotionally appealing and comforting - 3:6; 1 John 2:16.
- e. Knowledge and/or wisdom without understanding are _____ - Ecc. 1:18; Pro. 18:2; 1 Cor. 8:1; Pro. 4:1-2, 5-7; Matt. 13:14-15. BE CAREFUL where you get your knowledge and wisdom from - Pro. 2:6!

2. Counterfeit Power

- a. The 2nd half-truth: "ye shall be as _____, knowing good and evil" - 3:5.
- b. Adam & Eve likely knew exactly what this meant - Ex. 15:11; Ps. 86:8, 95:3, 136:2; Jer. 10:11. (*sons of God* - Job 38:7; Gen. 6:2.)
 - i. Idols represent fallen gods and have been worshipped by man ever since - Is. 44:10; Ps. 96:5, 97:7.

3. Counterfeit _____

- a. The 3rd half-truth: "ye shall not surely die". This would make complete sense to them given the lie that they would be "as gods."
- b. Though their physical body did not die, their spirit died thus corrupting them and all mankind born through them - Gen. 1:26-27; Heb. 4:12; 1 Thess. 5:23; Col. 2:9-13.

The Result

- They trusted the creature more than the Creator. They took the quick and seemingly easy path instead of _____ God's clear command (wisdom) - James 1:3-4; Rev. 14:12.
- Their decision has affected every human being since then by passing on a sinful nature and dead spirit...except for One!
- Satan did not ask Adam & Eve to follow him or worship him. He offered them nothing but half-truths, all to hurt God. He does not care one bit about humanity. We are nothing but pawns to accomplish his plan of being supreme ruler of the universe. He has NO remorse or guilt when it comes to destroying us. He masquerades as an angel of light (2 Cor. 11:14) BUT in reality, is a murderer, a liar (John 8:44) and a deceiver (Rev. 12:9, 20:10). In other words, he is a cheap _____ that looks and sounds good. SOUND FAMILIAR?????

Applying to AI

1. Getting spiritual guidance not from God's word, nor godly people, but from AI.
 - a. *Quick & easy*. - AI summaries.
 - b. Chatbots: providing "realistic" counsel to people on personal matters of life that are *emotionally appealing and comforting*.
 - c. "yea hath God said...": Partial truth leads to deliberate _____.
2. "ye shall not surely die"
 - a. Defying judgment, consequence, and cost - Rom. 5:12; Ps. 90:12.
 - b. Imagine trying to give the gospel when there are no consequences (the sting of death is removed).

We are now in a time where the toughest spiritual battle is not between truth and fiction, but between truth and "_____". While Satan's methods adapt with time, his motives are still the same. Are we seeing the beginning of his final system to rule the world?
