Today we are in the final section of Paul's letter to the church at Colosse which was to be read in and from the nearby church of Laodicea (v. 16). Paul ends his powerful letter to these churches by highlighting unique individuals who were significant to the success of this church and the world-wide gospel ministry. God does not waste verses in the Bible, and though this is simply a list of ten people in ten verses, it is important for us to glean from their personal testimonies and connect the work God was doing then, in and through them, to our work in our present time (Rom. 14:7).
