What's in a name? Why have a denominational name?

- A name reflects someone or something's **description** or _____ Gen. 17:1-6; 32:28; Matt. 1:21; Acts 13:9; Matt. 3:1; Mark 3:17; John 1:42.
- The denominational name **Baptist** means "one who baptizes or immerses in water" and was born in Europe through a chiding nickname given to people groups who held baptistic doctrines. The people groups called ______ were the Albigenses, Huguenots, Nestorians, Novations, Donatists, Paulicians, Patarines, Hutterites, Pauliceans, Mennonites, and Waldenses.

Baptists Worldwide

- There are approximately 50,000,000 Baptists in the United States (out of 327,000,000...15%). The Baptist denomination is the largest denomination in the United States behind the Catholic Church. Almost _____% of Baptists worldwide live in the United States.
- The largest populations of Baptists outside of the United States are in Asia, Africa, and Latin America, notably in <u>India</u> (2.4 million), <u>Nigeria</u> (2.3 million), the <u>Democratic Republic of the</u> <u>Congo</u> (1.9 million), and <u>Brazil</u> (1.5 million).
