## THE ROAD TO EMMAUS – Luke 24:13-32; Mark 16:12-13

### Before the Road – Luke 24:1-12; John 20:1-18; Mark 16:9-11

- Before **the sun** comes up, the **son of God** rises alive from death and the grave – v. 1a; Jn. 20:1.
- At least five women enter His tomb finding it empty and are **much** \_\_\_\_\_ – v. 1b-4b, 10a.
- Two angels \_\_\_\_\_ them what Jesus told them, and they return to tell the others – v. 5-9, 11.
- Peter and John race to the tomb, John \_\_\_\_\_, and they too find an empty tomb– v. 12; Jn. 20:1-10.
- Mary Magdalene sees Jesus Christ alive \_\_\_\_\_ and runs to tell the others – Jn. 20:11-18; Mk. 16:9-11.
- \_\_\_\_\_ atonement is made by Jesus Christ at the throne of God for our sins – Heb. 9:12, 26-28.

### On the Road – Luke 24:13-32

- Later in the day, two disciples (Cleopas and ???) walk away sadly from the resurrection discussing all that happened when Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ joins alongside them in the journey – v. 13-24, 29; Jn. 19:25.
- Jesus rebukes their lack of \_\_\_\_\_ in the Scripture and for hours reveals what they missed about Him from Genesis to Malachi – v. 25-27.
- The two \_\_\_\_\_ this stranger to join them for dinner, and after blessing and breaking bread together, they recognize Him and He vanishes out of their sight – v. 28-32.

*“Did not our hearts burn within us...while **he opened to us the Scriptures**” (v. 32) =*

### After the Road – Luke 24:33-41

- These two get right back on the road to Jerusalem to tell the others...who also do not \_\_\_\_\_ – v. 33-35; Mk. 16:12-13.
- The resurrected Jesus appears to them \_\_\_\_\_ in an instant of time...while they still struggle in unbelief – v. 36-41; Titus 2:13; 1 Pet. 1:7.
