	-	They in Jerusalem (as instructed) for the coming of the Holy Ghost upon them to continue the work of God – Acts 1:3-11; Rom. 5:6; 1 Tim. 2:6; 1 Pet. 5:6; 1 Cor. 6:19; 1 John 2:20.
	-	They sought the Lord for a twelfth apostle to replace Judas Iscariot in their important mission – Acts 1:15-26; Matt. 10:1-4, 19:27-28; Lk. 6:13; Ps. 109:1-8.
		Apostles (2 Cor. 12:12) =
	-	Peter was given special authority concerning and their leaders as the Kingdom of Heaven continued to be offered to Israel through his presence – Matt. 16:13-20; Gal. 2:7-9.
	-	The work of the 12 apostles when Israel's leaders continue to reject the Messiah through the preaching of Stephen and Peter ending in Jerusalem's destruction in 70 AD – Acts 2, 7, 12:1-24.
	-	Some apostles wrote NT booksJames, 1/2 Peter, 1/2/3 John,, Revelation – Rom. 10:12-13.

	-	Jesus chose a very special vessel in a special way, one final apostle, to His mission to reach the Gentile world – Acts 9:1-16, 16:37, 22:27-28; 1 Cor. 9:20-23; Rom. 11:13-14, 25.
	-	Paul was an unusual apostle with a very story/mission – 1 Cor. 15:7-9; Acts 26:12-20; 1 Tim. 1:15-17; Gal. 1:1, 13-18; 1 Pet. 2:9.
3.	Ne	ew Testament Churches and Pastors
	-	Paul wrote to seven key New Testament churches, of which he founded himselfCorinth, Galatia, Ephesus, Phillipi, and Thessalonicaand to two pastors ( <i>Timothy &amp; Titus</i> ) – Eph. 2:19-22.
	-	Because these all continued in their timewe are here in Greentown today doing this same work!  May we also to be faithful in this work until we finish our course – 2 Tim. 3:13-14, 4:6-7.
