Revelation 21:22 - 22:5

- ²² And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb.
- ²³ And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb.
- ²⁴ By its light will the nations walk, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it,
- ²⁵ and its gates will never be shut by day—and there will be no night there.
- ²⁶ They will bring into it the glory and the honor of the nations.

Revelation 21:22 - 22:5

- ²⁷ But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.
- 22:1 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb
- ² through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

Revelation 21:22 - 22:5

- ³ No longer will there be anything accursed, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and his servants will worship him.
- ⁴ They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads.
- ⁵ And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever.

- 1. The full presence of and acceptance by God is the essence and treasure of Heaven.
 - A Throughout Scripture, God guarantees that He will dwell with His people. (Lev. 26:11–12; Ezek. 37:27; 2 Cor. 6:16)
 - B. We are to leave and cleave to our spouse; and it is no different with Christ. (Genesis 2:24; Revelation 21:2)
 - C. Longing for Heaven is longing most of all for God's presence and not just His heavenly presents.

- 2. Church services will not be necessary in Heaven; for there will be pure, unending worship and fellowship in everything we do.
 - A There will be no Temple in Heaven because all of Heaven will be the Temple (Rev. 21:22)
 - B. Likewise, there will be no church service in Heaven because all of Heaven will be the Church.
 - C. Living in Heaven will be worship.
 - 1. It will be multicultural without any racial divisions. (Phil. 2:10–11; Rev. 7:9)
 - 2. Worship will be an eternal exploration and uncovering of God's infinite glory. It will be the greatest adventure!
 - 3. It will not be boring! (Psalm 16:11)
 - D. Let's not wait until Heaven to make worship our lifestyle.

3. We don't have to wait until Heaven to experience God's presence and glory.
