Heaven In View

Psalm 16:5-11

⁵ The Lord is my chosen portion and my cup; you hold my lot.

⁶ The lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance.

⁷ I bless the Lord who gives me counsel; in the night also my heart instructs me.

⁸ I have set the Lord always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken.

⁹ Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure.

Psalm 16:5-11

¹⁰ For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption.

¹¹ You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

1. Endless time will fly by in endless joy and pleasure.

- A. As finite people, eternity is hard, if not impossible, to grasp.
- B. Psalm 16:11 In the perfect presence of God there is nothing but complete joy and eternal pleasures.
- C. We will work and have responsibilities in Heaven, but our work won't be just vocation. It will be avocation because we will love what we do.
- D. We will get to be creative.
- E We will have lots of fun.

2. The rest of creation will be redeemed in Heaven with animals seemingly being present.

- A. Romans 8:18–23 All of creation will be redeemed/restored as part of God's plan for the redemption and resurrection of mankind.
- B. Revelation 21:1 The New Heaven and Earth will be like the old, just without sin and its effects.

3. Pets may or may not be in Heaven, but it would be just like God to allow our favorite pets to be with us.

- A Animals have life from God but probably not souls.
- B. But wouldn't it be just like God if He allowed our favorite pets to be there, out of His love for us?
- C. Whatever Heaven holds, it will be exactly what will yield for us complete joy and eternal pleasures.
