II SLIDE Our Mission

- A) 2 Timothy 4:1-2 (NIV) ¹ In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, ² Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction.
 - 1) Preach with great patience and with sound doctrine
 - Correct, rebuke, and encourage out of love and not out of anger or vengeance
- B) **SLIDE** Our ministry
 - 1) Matthew 5:9 (NIV) [Jesus said,] 9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.
 - 2) 2 Corinthians 5:17-20 (NIV) ¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! ¹⁸ All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: ¹⁹ that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. ²⁰ We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

III SLIDE Prepare Now for....

A) 2 Timothy 4:3-5 (NIV). ³ For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what

their itching ears want to hear. ⁴ They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. ⁵ But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.

- 1) SLIDE Who are "they" about whom Paul speaks? Christians
- 2) They will not put up the sound doctrine of Jesus Christ, the only truth that can save us and redeem us
- 3) People will seek a doctrine that fits their own desires
- 4) We can see this daily
- 5) Again, Paul is warning us not to fall into this trap
- 6) We can feel the temptation to seek a truth that fits our desires of hate, love, anger, lust, selfishness, etc.
- 7) Paul is speaking of believers
- 8) If believers forsake sound doctrine, then who will be left to reconcile people to God
- 9) SLIDE Matthew 24:24 (NIV) [Jesus said,] ²⁴ For false Christs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and miracles to deceive even the elect--if that were possible.
- 10) We need to be grounded solidly in His word so that we do not stray from the sound doctrine of Jesus Christ
- 11) Paul speaks of a time when people will seek instruction, teaching that is more comfortable to their wishes and feelings
- 12) We see this tendency sweeping through our college campuses
- 13) I have to be aware of this when I listen to the news or read stories
- 14) I gravitate toward those who tickle my ears and shy away from those who do not
- 15) However, that is not how we discover the truth
- 16) We are seeing in our time when people gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear
- 17) If I preach in favor of our right to bear arms because I know the majority of this church agrees, then I am tickling your ear

- 18) If I use the scriptures to defend a stance against sin to get Amens from you, then I am tickling your ear
- 19) If we bring in guest speakers who will back up our beliefs, then we are dangerously close to having our ears tickled
- 20) **SLIDE** Instead, we are to seek those who speak the truth because it is the truth
- 21) The truth should challenge, change, correct, rebuke, sharpen and encourage us
- 22) The truth does not tickle our ears
- 23) This may sound simplistic, but any message that is based soundly on the Bible should be able to be preached in any church in any denomination
- 24) If any of you respond with an "Amen" to this message or any message, it should be because you agree with the truth of Jesus Christ and not with me
- B) They will seek myths
 - 1) One day is like a 1,000 to God; therefore, creation could have lasted 6,000 years, allowing for evolution
 - Our final resting place is determined by our intentions and not by our actions
 - 3) New revelation allows us to "update" the Bible so it is more applicable to our lives today
 - 4) Hell is only a holding place until we can find our way to heaven
 - 5) You do not have to take the Bible literally to believe in Jesus
 - 6) We are not under the law; therefore, we are free to do as we please
 - Sin is no longer sin; instead, sin is often the result of our prejudices
- C) SLIDE 5 But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.
 - 1) We are to keep our heads

- 2) We are to keep sober, clearheaded, not muddled by false doctrine or our itching ears
- 3) Keep our heads so we do not engage in frivolous discussions or arguments
- 4) Keep our heads so we will not be bated into a trap
- 5) We are to be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry
- 6) When we do speak, we are to speak with patience and sound doctrine
- 7) SLIDE We endure hardships because if we will not listen to false doctrines and if we will keep our heads, we will encounter hardships
- 8) We are to do the work of one who proclaims the gospel
- 9) We are to discharge all the duties of our ministries
- 10) We all have a ministry
- 11) We all have duties associated with those ministries
- 12) We are not to leave our work for someone else
