Romans 12:1-2 (NIV) <sup>1</sup> Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. <sup>2</sup> Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

I woke to learn that another major vulnerability was discovered that affected my computer, tablet, and watch. We were urged to update immediately, which I did. As I waited for the update to be installed, I marveled at the process. My device was downloading code via the air and storing it on my device.
