1. When couples get married, what did you think they signed up for when they said, "I do"?
2. **Read Ephesians 5:31-32.** God chose marriage as the picture to the world about how Jesus relates to us. How does this help clarify, not just the foundation of marriage, but our roles in marriage, too?
3. **Read Ephesians 5:22-33.** After listening to the entire message, reflect on your own role in your marriage. What is it that God is calling you to in your marriage? How is that going for you? What are you doing well? Where could you grow? (if you don't know, ask your spouse) What is an attitude that needs to change and an action that needs to be taken for your marriage to become more like what God intended?

Heavenly Father, our marriages are to reflect the glorious Gospel of Jesus Christ. Forgive us for falling short. May we build a better culture of marriage in the church that portrays our relationship with Jesus. AMEN.

MESSAGE MEMORY VERSE:
