PSALM 73 SEEK AND EXPERIENCE THE PRESENCE OF GOD



1- Envy (Common sin)

- Asaph's struggle with envy (verses 1-16)
- Asaph envied the wicked (verse 3)
- Envy led to a temporary perspective
- Asaph was focused on the earthly riches of the wicked (verse 12)
- Envy led to emotional brokenness and doubt (verses 13,14)

2-Wise Decision (Verse 17)

- Asaph went into God's sanctuary
- Sanctuary defined as a place of safety and refuge; where one feels especially safe
- God's présence is our sanctuary
- In the midst of envy and brokenness, Aspah sought to experience God's presence
- God's presence within us (1 Corinthians 3:16)
- We need to seek and experience the presence of God in the midst of struggle

3- Transformed Heart (verses 18-28)

- In God's presence, Asaph realized his own foolishness (verses 21-22)
- From envy to contentment (verses 23-26)
- In God's presence, Asaph understood the ultimate destiny of the wicked (verse 27)
- Jesus is the only way (John 14:6)

4- Holy moments in God's presence (Application)

- Seek holy moments with God in our everyday lives
- God can transform our hearts through the power of his presence
- Come into his presence with all our struggles, failures and weaknesses.
- Because of Christ, we are not unworthy to come into his presence (2 Corinthians 5:21)
- As we spend time with God we will experience the transforming power of his presence
