FINDING REST IN GOD ALONE

Scripture Reading: Psalm 62

Sermon Outline

- God's Peace During Difficult Times (Psalm 62:1-4)
- God's Peace Reaffirmed (Psalm 62:5-8)
- God's Peace Realized (Psalm 62:9-12)

Psalm 62 is one of the most practical Psalms in the psalter. It teaches us how to take care of ourselves under difficult circumstances.



Psalm 62 speaks to a condition common to all people of all ages in all cultures. It speaks to the fact that a person cannot find true rest/peace in life apart from God.

God's Peace During Difficult Times

David's rest is not in the things that are happening around him (good or bad) but it is in God who is sustaining him during this challenging (difficult) time in his life.

"You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You."

- Saint Augustine

Jesus is clear and there is no ambiguity his statement! There will be trouble in this world but it is in Him that we have and find peace! (John 16:33)

God's Peace Reaffirmed

David reaffirms to himself to trust in God and we should follow this example to bolster our faith in Him.

David shows us a picture of what life is like when God is our only option. (Luke 18:35-43).

1 Peter 5:7 "Cast all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you."

We must keep reminding ourselves to recognize, in any given situation, the presence, promises and

providence (foresight – wisdom) of God, which are ours in Christ Jesus.

God's Peace Realized

David points out the final analysis of wicked and arrogant people: they are but a breath (James 4:14).
