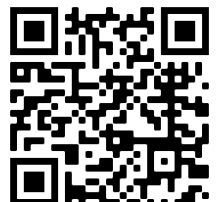

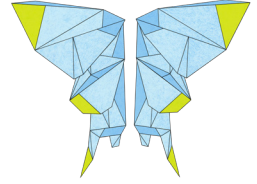

RESEMBLING CHRIST



1. Receive Christ
2. Remain in Christ

3. RESEMBLE CHRIST

- a. **SET** your HEART on Christ
- b. **PUT** to Death Sin
- c. **PUT** on the Clothes of Christ
- d. **PRESENT** the Love of Christ

- 1. RECEIVE CHRIST

Col. 1:13-14 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Col 2:13 When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins.

- 2. Receive and **REMAIN IN CHRIST**

Col 2:6-7 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

- 3. RESEMBLE CHRIST

Col 1:28 We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may **present everyone perfect in Christ**

- a. **SET** your HEART on Christ

Col 3:1-4 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, **set your hearts on things above**, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. **Set your minds on things above**, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

- b. **PUT** to Death Sin (Kill your sin with Christ's People)

Col 3:5-10 **Put to death**, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. But now you **must rid yourselves** of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

Col. 3:11 Here there is no Greek or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.

- c. **PUT** on the Clothes of Christ

Col 3:12-14 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, **clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience**. Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues **put on love**, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

- d. **PRESENT** Christ to the World

Col 3:12-14 - see above...and...

Col 3:15-16 **Let the peace of Christ** rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. **Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly** as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

Col 3:17 And **whatever you do**, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
