

I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Scripture Reading: John 3:17-21, 8:12

The likely context of Jesus saying "I AM the Light of the World": It was the custom in the evening, of the Feast of Tabernacles, to light up two large golden chandeliers in the court of the women, the light of which illuminated all Jerusalem. All that night they



held a festival dance by the light. These golden bowls (reached by ladders) were filled with oil and when they were lit at night (so the rabbis said), all Jerusalem was illuminated. In a world that did not have public lighting after dusk, this light shining from Jerusalem's yellow limestone walls must have been spectacular. Choirs of Levites would sing during the lighting while people danced in the streets, carrying torches and singing hymns. God as LIGHT was huge for the people of God, you can think of many examples throughout the Bible of God as light.

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." - John 8:12

Why is this good news for us? Because naturally we are in sin, in darkness and unable to know the truth of God without supernatural intervention (Ephesians 5:8; 2 Cor. 4:4)

Notice right before this passage a woman was caught in the act of adultery and his sin was exposed but Jesus protected and redeemed her. Getting caught in our sin just may be the kindness of God!

Why stay in the darkness and keep on sinning? We usually do this because we're afraid of getting caught, afraid of the consequences of our actions and might believe the way of sin is more enjoyable than the way of Jesus. If you are living in unconfessed sin and think you're getting away with it, it's possible the warning in Romans 1 is applied to you:

<u>Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts</u> to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another. - Romans 1:24

The truth is that the Lord sees all, knows all and still invites you to repentance, believing and living in the light! (Ephesians 5:8)

Gospel - God leading us from darkness to light (2 Corinthians 4:6-7)

When we accept Jesus and experience God's grace, the pressure is off from feeling that we have to live "perfect" or make it look like we have it all together. The light of Jesus shines through our failures

If you want Jesus to be the light of the world to you and through you to others, you must be honest with yourself and others when it comes to our sin and failures (Ephesians 5:11-13)

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves. - Colossians 1:13

I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness. -.lohn 12:46
