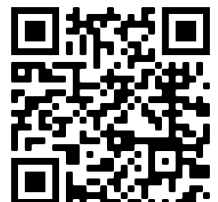

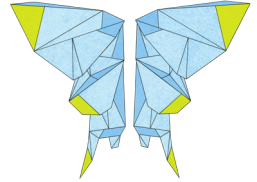

The "Gospel"

There is more to the gospel than the forgiveness of sins-but the forgiveness of sins is at the heart of the gospel.

Mtw 1:21, Mtw 26:28, Mark 10:45, Luke 15:1-7, Luke 15:8-10, Luke 15:11-32, Luke 24:46-48, John 3:16-18, John 3:36, Acts 2:38, Acts 3:19, Acts 13:38-39, Acts 26:17-18, Romans 1:16-18, Romans 3:22-26, Romans 4:3, 4:9, 4:13, 4:25

Today our Text is Romans 5... More Gospel

Romans 5:6-8 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

The Gospel and the Word "THROUGH"

Romans 5:9-11 Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life! Not only is this so, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

Are you living "THROUGH Adam"? or

Are you living "THROUGH CHRIST"?

Romans 5:12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man (Adam), and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned—

Romans 5:15 But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man (Adam), how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many!

Romans 5:17 For if, by the trespass of the one man (Adam), death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man (Adam) the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man (Jesus Christ) the many will be made righteous.

Romans 5:20 The law was added so that the trespass might increase. But where sin increased, grace increased all the more, so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
