1. Paul's word of warning

Watch out for those dogs, those evildoers, those mutilators of the flesh.

See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ. Colossians 288

2. Who Are We? We are God's people.

Watch out for those dogs... For it is we who are the circumcision

So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. Galatians 326-28

3. How do we serve? We serve by God's Spirit.
