REWIRING YOUR HEART WROMANS 7

What is sin?

- Started in heaven with pride and rebellion → God cast out Satan and ½ of the angels
- Humanity's first sin was the twisting of God's words, not trusting God and believing they were better off without him (Genesis 3)
- Sin is inherited and part of our nature (Romans 5:12)
- Why do we sin? We sin because we want to

Scripture Reading: Luke 6:43-45

- The Bible teaches us that we need a new heart and that God offers this to those who repent and believe (Deut. 30:6; Ps. 51:10; Jer. 24:7, 31:33; Ezek. 11:19-20, 36:26; Rom. 2:29)
- The Bible also shows us that when we will ourselves to behave and do the right thing but don't really mean it is not true obedience (Ps. 51:17; Is. 29:13; Matt. 15:8, 23:27)
- You cannot just unplug your affections and desires. They must be rewired and reordered. Example of a hardwired want in the human heart

- This is where people would say we need self-control but before you do anything you need to sit with God and get to the heart of the problem
 - Fighting off the ants story
 - There is a command to deny, put off and put to death old sinful ways (Matt.16:24; Eph. 4:22; Col. 3:5)

We need God to realign and repurpose the hardwired desires that are inside of us:

- When we try to distract ourselves from our wants and desires it is like trying to submerge a beach ball under the water. In time, the ball is going to pop back up. Instead of trying to just suppress these desires and wants, submit them to the Lord and ask him to reorder the affections of your heart. This begins by re-evangelizing yourself.
 - Retell and rehearse the story of salvation. Speak God's word and God's truth over and over yourself. (Exodus 20:2; John 17:17)

Time of Reflection - "What is the Gospel"

God... is Holy. Exodus 34:6-7

Man... is a **Sinner**. Romans 3:23, Romans 3:10 **Christ**... is the **SAVIOR**. John 3:16, Romans 6:23

Response... Repent and **Believe**. Mark 1:15. Acts 20:21
