PALM SUNDAY

- The Prophecy...of the coming messiah!

Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

- New Testament Reading

Matthew v2:1-11...Triumphal Entrance John 12:12-19...Triumphal Entrance

- The very next scene...in John's' Gospel...John 12:20-33
 - a) The Greeks (Gentiles) want to see Jesus (John 12:20-22)
 - b) This leads Jesus to say "The hour has come" for His glorification (the cross) (v. 23-26)
 - c) Jesus asks should he be saved from this hour (the cross) (v. 27-28)
 - d) Lifted up (on the cross) Jesus will draw all people to himself. (v. 30-33)
- The Outline of the Sermon
 - 1. SAVE US!!...the people say.
 - 2. SAVE ME!!...Jesus does not say.
 - 3. SAVE YOU?...Do you need "salvation"? Do others?
- Questions:
 - 1. What kind of a Savior did the people want then? How about us in America today? (SAVE US!!)
 - 2. Why are your grateful that Jesus didn't say ("SAVE ME"!!)
 - 3. Do you need the SAVIOR Jesus as He is revealed in the Bible? (SAVE YOU?) Do others?
- Closing Question
 - 1. Who are you inviting/bringing to Good Friday Services? 5:30pm and 7:00pm
 - 2. Who are you inviting to Easter (RESURRECTION SUNDAY) Services? 9:00am, 10:30am, 12:00pm and 6pm
