

2 Truths & 1 Lie

Scripture Reading: Psalm 5:4-10

V. 4-6 talk about God's holiness

- God takes no pleasure in evil (5:4)
- The wicked cannot be by you (5:4)
- Arrogant cannot be by you (5:5)
- God hates all who do wrong (5:5)
- God destroys lies (5:6)
- God despises deceit (5:6)

Sun analogy - incompatible with anything else

- 27,000,000 degrees Fahrenheit
- 333,000x bigger than earth
- 330,000,000,000,000 horsepower of energy to the earth each day
 - Just like it's not possible for us to get close to the sun so God is incompatible with sin. It's just not possible

Expose the lies - give us the truth! (Psalm 5:6,9)

Expose the lies - give us the truth! (Ephesians 5:8-13)

V. 7-8 God's not only opposed to sin he's relentlessly good!

- God is merciful (5:7) → woman caught in adultery
- God is holy $(5:7) \rightarrow$
- God is righteous (5:8) → transfiguration
- God guides us in right living (5:8) → it's not about following the rules legally but loving God and neighbor

Sun analogy - it's not only powerful but also very good!

- Helps decrease blood pressure
- Promotes bone health
- Increases brain function
- Boosts immune system
- Promotes food growth
