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"A TIME FOR PEACE"

- Scripture Reading: Luke 2: 8-14

- Theme: True Peace comes from God alone!

Peace Defined:

- Eirene (Greek New Testament): the absence of war, rest, tranquility, harmony, security or to have quiet.
- Shalom (Hebrew Old Testament): complete, safe, untouched, tranquility, harmony, everything is good, well or whole.

The peace of God in-Christ can never be separated from God himself. If we want peace, Christ must first rule in our lives. God's purpose is not to give us peace separate from himself. (John 14:27)

Peace is a fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). If we are allowing the Spirit of God to rule in our lives, we will experience the Lord's peace into Advent. We celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ leading up to Christmas and beyond.

Peace with God

All human beings are born with the first parents' (Adam and Eve) sin nature. (Romans 5:12)

The scripture says very plainly that the central and/or natural condition of our hearts is hostility toward God. (Romans 8:7)

At advent, it is only through Jesus and faith in him that we are brought into a relationship of peace with our God and Creator. It is the reconciliation of God with us. (Colossians 1:21)

Peace with others

"There will never be agreement at the peace tables of the world or rest in the individual heart until the Prince of Peace reigns supreme in the hearts of men." William Bright

The scripture is very clear that we as Christians are commanded to do our part in peacemaking. (Ephesians 4:31–32)

Peace with self
