DANIEL 12: HOPE

The most dangerous part of Daniel's life occurred in Daniel 8-12 (Daniel 10:12-13)



Scripture Reading: Daniel 12:1-13

The Archangel Michael came to Daniel's aid. He is Satan's counterpart. (Daniel 12:1)

- Remember God has no counterpart. He stands alone as Holy!

God guarantees a resurrection and judgment (Daniel 12:2)

Jesus, the Son of Man, will be executing the holy judgment (John 5:24-29)

God again guarantees all wrongs will be made right (Daniel 12:4,7)

Like a child asking the parent, "are we there yet?" We often ask God the same question, "when is this going to happen?" (Daniel 12:6)

When Daniel asks what he is to do in his time of waiting he is told two different times "Go your way". Essentially Daniel is told to remain faithful and to continue doing what he's been doing. (Daniel 12:8-9,13)

What do we know to do?

- Pray (Matthew 6:9-15)
- Sabbath (Mark 2:23-28)
- Worship together (Hebrews 10:25)
- Be ready to share your faith (1 Peter 3:15)
- Be devoted to the reading of Scripture, to preaching and to teaching (1 Timothy 4:13)
- Speak of Jesus (2 Timothy 4:2)
- Give your time, money and resources (Acts 20:35)
- Godly marriage (Ephesians 5:25)
- Children honor your father and mother (Ephesians 6:2)
- Love your neighbor as yourself (Mark 12:31)

Wait well - hope in the Lord. Don't waste your waiting (Daniel 12:10-12)
