Project Hope serves our local community with a weekly Food Bank distribution every Friday from 8-10am at 8206 Alondra Blvd.

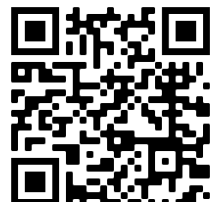

# THE GOSPEL/RECONCILIATION FOR ALL "ETHNE"



## - Scripture Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! All this is from God, who **reconciled** us to himself through Christ and gave us the **ministry of reconciliation**: that God was **reconciling** the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the **message of reconciliation**. We are therefore **Christ's ambassadors**, as though God were making his appeal through us. **We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.** God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (v.21... is the gospel!)

## - The Gospels and Reconciliation of the "Ethne" in Christ

MTW 28:18-20

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore **go and make disciples of all nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to **obey everything I have commanded you**. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Luke 24:45-47

Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. He told them, "This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and **repentance and forgiveness of sins** will be preached in his name to **all nations**, beginning at Jerusalem."
