Judith Shulevitz illuminates the image of the one who forgets the Sabbath: "The rabbis (discussed) the legal implications of forgetting the Sabbath...What would the penalty for such amnesia or ignorance be? And what kind of Jew could be so oblivious to the Sabbath? Only, the rabbis thought, a Jew who had suffered extreme cultural dislocation. *Only a Jew who had been kidnapped as a child and raised by non-Jews*."
