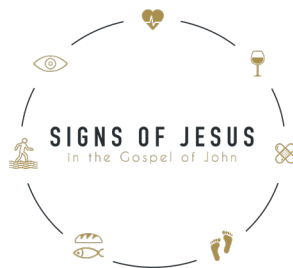

Scripture Reading – John 9:1-12

1. Who is Jesus?

Jesus is God

- John 1:1, John 1:14, John 8:58

- "I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!"

2. What does Jesus do?

Jesus Heals and Saves

- John 9:1-12 – He heals the blind man.

- John 9:35 – He pursues/finds the blind (now seeing) man – again.

- John 9:35-38 – He leads the blind (seeing) man to eternal life.

- Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, and when he **found him**, he said, "Do you **believe** in the Son of Man?" "Who is he, sir?" the man asked. "Tell me so that I may believe in him." Jesus said, "You have now seen him; in fact, he is the one speaking with you." Then the man said, "**Lord, I believe,**" and he **worshiped** him.

3. What does the blind man do?

Tell Your Jesus Story Tell The Jesus Story

- He obeys John...not fully understanding.

- John 9:7 "**Go,**" he told him, "**wash** in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means Sent). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing.

- He tells others what he knows of Jesus.

- John 9:11 He replied, "The man they call Jesus made some mud and put it on my eyes. He told me to go to Siloam and wash. So I went and washed, and then I could see."

- He says "I don't know" – a lot.

- John 9:12 "Where is this man?" they asked him. "**I don't know,**" he said.

- He asks questions of his questioners.

- John 9:27 He answered, "I have told you already and you did not listen. Why do you want to hear it again? Do you want to become his disciples, too?"

- He asks Jesus questions.

- John 9:35-36 Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, and when he found him, he said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" "**Who** is he, sir?" the man asked. "Tell me so that I may believe in him."

- He Believes, Worships, Testifies.

- John 9:38 Then the man said, "Lord, **I believe,**" and he **worshiped** him.
