THE GOSPEL Nov 13, 2022

Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the **gospel** I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this **gospel** you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, that he was **buried**, that he was **raised on the third day** according to the Scriptures. -1 Cor 15:1-4

The Call to Repentance

#### Repent.

- 1. **Repent** was the first word of John the Baptist's gospel (Matthew 3:1-2).
- 2. **Repent** was the first word of Jesus' gospel (Matthew 4:17 and Mark 1:14-15).
- 3. **Repent** was the first word in the preaching ministry of the twelve disciples (Mark 6:12)
- 4. **Repent** was the first word in the preaching instructions Jesus gave to His disciples after His resurrection (Luke 24:46-47).
- 5. **Repent** was the first word of exhortation in the first sermon of Peter (Acts 2:38)
- 6. **Repent,** then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, (Acts 3:19)
- 7. **Repent** was the first word in the mouth of the Apostle Paul through his ministry (Acts 26:19-20).
- Repenting & Believing to Enter Christs Kingdom

Mark 1:14-15 (Jesus)

After John was put in prison, Jesus went into Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God. "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God is near. **Repent and believe** the good news!"

Acts 20:21 (Paul)

I have declared to both Jews and Greeks that they must turn to God in **repentance** and have **faith** in our Lord Jesus.

#### YOU/WE NEED JESUS

- Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved." -Acts 4:12
- Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father excep through me. John 14:6

- 1. God is great and glorious.




