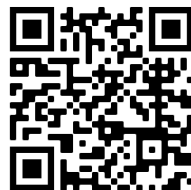

No Quid Pro Quo



Quid Pro Quo

- latin : "something for something"

Scripture reading: 2 Samuel 7:1-17

How did we get to this place of rest?

- After years of disobedience leaders rose up who followed God's instruction obediently
- After years of unfaithfulness leaders partnered with God and his faithfulness

My translation of what David was saying to God in 2 Samuel 7:2, "God I want to do something for you, I'm going to build a temple for you!"

"There are many examples of ancient Near-Eastern kings "paying" for the blessing of their deity through the construction of a temple in a kind of quid pro quo contract - I build you a magnificent temple; you enable me to live long, prosper and defeat my enemies"

God makes it clear there is no "Quid Pro Quo" in our relationship. He says:

- I brought the Israelites up out of Egypt, I took you from the pasture
- I appointed you ruler, I have been with you
- I have cut off all your enemies, I will make your name great
- I will plant them, I will give you rest
- I the Lord will establish a house for you, I will raise up your offspring
- I will establish his kingdom, I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever
- I will be his father

Read 2 Samuel 7 and compare it to the word from the Lord to Jesus' mother Mary in Luke 1. You see how clearly 2 Samuel 7 points to Jesus in Luke 1:31-33

Our response to God should be similar to that of David in 2 Samuel 7:18-22

Reflection Questions:

- Where in your life have you lived in a Quid Pro Quo relationship (transaction) with God?

- Spend time praising God for his faithfulness in your life. What are some examples that come to mind?
