## "SPEND LESS"

- Scripture Reading: Matthew 6: 19-24



- Two Treasures (vv. 19 - 21)

- Two Conditions (vv. 22 - 23)

- Two Masters (vv. 24)



Our spending reveals what we believe. Are we buying things we do not necessarily need or want? Is this the choice we should be making? Is this the true story of Christmas, of Advent. We can sometimes lose sight of what Christmas is about.

This "Season of Blessing" during Advent is designed to assist us in developing and/or reaffirming the right perspective on Christmas.

#### - Two Treasures (vv. 19 - 21)

Jesus said, "Don't store up for yourselves treasures on earth (v. 19). But store up treasure in heaven" (v. 20). That's about as clear as directions get!

It is not money itself, but the love of money, which is seen by Scripture as a fundamental cause of evil (1 Timothy 6:10). It is God who gives us everything we have! (Deuteronomy 8:17-18)

"You can never get enough of what you don't need to make you happy." (Eric Hoffer)

#### - Two Conditions (vv. 22 - 23)

This passage is diagnostic, and Jesus' message is "Examine yourself." And don't ignore your hearts orientation toward God (Luke 11:34-35).

Some people can completely focus their eyes on wealth and then there are others who love God and have fallen into bad habits. Therefore, distraction by earthly riches can darken the eye and we need to reshape our viewpoints, including our perspective on gift giving.

Remember; The discipline of the healthy eye reflects a heart that is set on the kingdom of God.

### - Two Masters (vv. 24)

The Lord is personifying money in this scripture. He is stating that money is a rival god, a rival lord or master. Jesus would not have divided allegiance among his disciples (Matthew 12:30). "Every treasure but Jesus insists you die to purchase it. Jesus is the one treasure that died to purchase you." (Tim Keller)

- What does it mean for you to spend less during this advent season?
