

BIBLICAL AUTHORITY

Scripture Reading: Genesis 3:1-24

- Genesis 3 brought about the curse . There was a rejection of God's intentions and deliberate actions against the will of God.

- Creation was from then on in sin and is dysfunctional at every level. People like Freud taught, and teach today, that if only the desires of our hearts were met then all would be right in the world. Find what pleases you and enjoy it. Resist any authority that stands between you and what comes natural to you.



- The problem then is this, who gets to decide what is right and wrong?

For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. - 2 Timothy 4:3

- What would happen if we all got to redefine what a red, yellow, and green light meant?

- Israel failed to break the curse and be a blessing to the world so God sent Jesus. Jesus shows us immediately what "biblical authority" looks like (Matthew 4)

- Satan misuses Deuteronomy 8 to fit his agenda

- Thomas Jefferson cut and paste bible

- To combat Satan - Jesus not only quoted the scriptures correctly but more than that, Jesus believed the words of God, trusted the words of God and lived out the Words of God.

- Bad dream story "I say the words but they don't work"
- Deliverance story quietly and peacefully quoting scripture

Hermeneutics - interpreting, understanding and explaining the Bible

- 1. What did the author intend the original audience to hear?
- 2. Read the passage through the lens of the Gospel (snake, Moses, being saved)
- 3. Obey the same teachings the Christian Church have obeyed since the time of Jesus

- Biblical "Cross Reference" Image by Pastor Chris Harrison

- 40 men - 1500 years - 3 continents - 3 languages - 63,779 cross references ... all pointing to Jesus as God our Savior

- Jesus taught as one who had "authority" (Matthew 7:28-29)

Authority - exousia - power to act

eksousía (ek, "out from," which intensifies, /eimí, "to be, being as a right or privilege") – authority, conferred power; delegated empowerment ("authorization")

- Don't just study the Bible, let the Bible study you! (Psalm 139:23-24)

- The Bible contains everything we need for faith and salvation (Luke 16:27-31)
