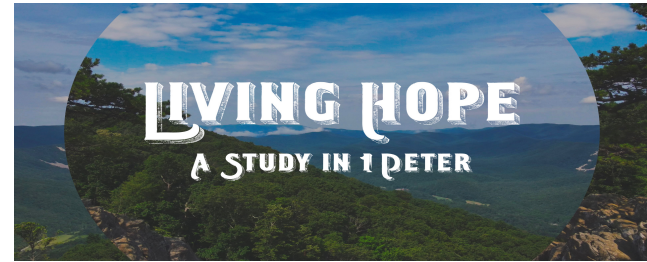




7. Seeing how important the Scriptures were to the prophets, how should this affect your own appreciation for, and commitment to, the Scriptures on a daily basis?
