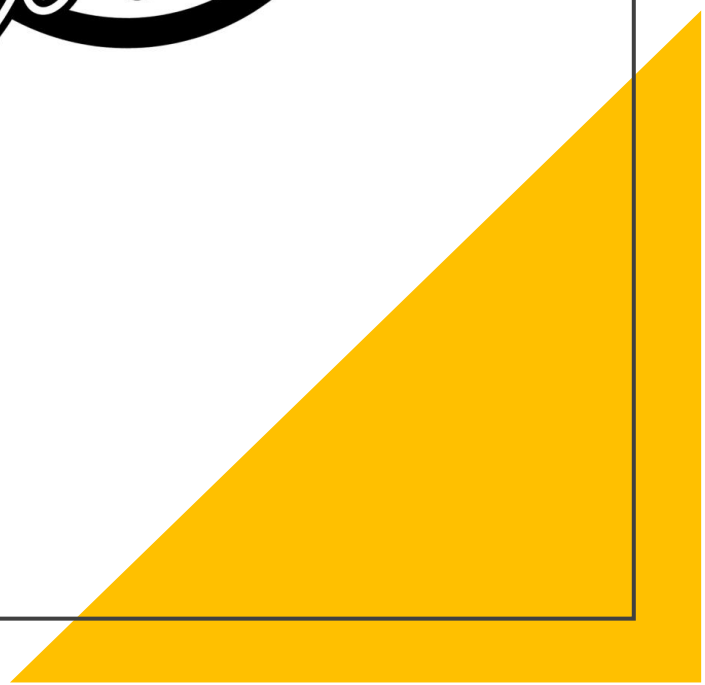

4. He perfectly executes vengeance against the oppressors (Romans 12:19)
5. God is just in meting out rewards (Hebrews 6:10)
6. He is equally just in meting out punishments (Colossians 3:25)
7. Justice and righteousness, always work hand in hand (Psalm 89:14)
