


Pride is a deadly sin that can easily go undetected in our lives. A simple pat on our back or a "good job" can slowly evolve into so much more.

THE DANGER OF SPIRITUAL PRIDE



PRIDE Danger #1:

Pride Develops an Unrealistic View of Ourselves

Romans 12:3, "Don't think you are better than you really are. Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves, measuring yourselves by the faith God has given us."





PRIDE Danger #2:

Pride Detaches Us from Community

"God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble" (James 4:6b ESV)





PRIDE Danger #3:

Pride Creates a Critical Spirit

Sermon on the Mount,

"Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye."





PRIDE Danger #4:

Pride Takes Life into Our Own Hands

"Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall" (Proverbs 16:18 ESV)





Our Defense Against Pride: Humility

"If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it" (Luke 9:23-24 ESV)





Our Defense Against Pride: Humility

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you." (1 Peter 5:6 ESV)
