Why are names important?





SCRIBES

- Names were copied very carefully by hand by men called scribes.
- A scribe wouldn't write the name of God with the same pen with which he wrote other names. He had a special “God pen.” It was only used for writing God's name.
- When the scribe would get to the name of God, he would leave a blank space. Later he would go back and write in the name of God with the “God pen.”
- Each time he wrote the name of God, he would say, “I am writing the name of God for the holiness of His name.”
- If he made a mistake while writing God's name, he would destroy the whole page of papyrus or vellum.
