


Luke 11: 5-10

Context/Background

- A parable about prayer
- Disciples were asking Jesus how to pray
- Jesus' first response is the iconic "Lord's Prayer"



Pointers and Cautions



This parable is about PRAYER and how WE should be praying.

4 Points

- 1. What's the need?
- 2. ASK! Make the request!
- 3. KEEP praying/KEEP begging
- 4. Accept God's answer

What's the need?

Holy Spirit

We must be aware that there is a need.

Self-Reflection

Awareness of surroundings

You can't pray for something if you don't even know what to pray for.

What's the need?

There are internal and external needs.

Physical and non-physical needs.



Don't be scared to share your prayer requests with others. The only thing you're risking is receiving blessings from God and support from your peers.

ASK! Make the request!

The host took action. What does that look like for us? <u>Prayer</u> - our communication with God.

When did he take action? RIGHT AWAY!

ASK! Make the request!

What is your first instinct when you're caught in a situation or need something?

Is God our first solution or last resort?

Side note:


Prayer is powerful. **GOD** is powerful.

Do not belittle either of them.

KEEP praying/KEEP begging

The host kept asking for food for HIS GUEST, not himself

The host depended on his neighbor to give him bread, so he kept begging and begging until he received what he was looking for.



3 Answers God can give:

Maybe/Later

Yes

No

3 Answers God can give:



Maybe/Later

We keep praying because "maybe" MAY BE answered in the future. He might just be testing your faith and dependence

We need to be listening as much as we are praying

3 Answers God can give:



<u>Yes</u>

Thank Him! Give God the praise and glory He deserves if He gives you what you're asking for

3 Answers God can give:



<u>No</u>

No ≠ maybe/later

No = no

Don't try forcing God to turn no into a yes

3 Answers God can give:



<u>No</u>

Work outside God's will and you will only be getting subpar results


God knows what's best for you and has the best plans for you.

3 Answers God can give:

<u>No</u>

Do not see "No" as a bad thing.









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
