We are on our way to Easter, while historically, Jesus is on His way to the Cross.

Luke 19:1-10 (CSB) *He entered Jericho and was passing through.<sup>2</sup> There was a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.<sup>3</sup> He was trying to see who Jesus was, but he was not able because of the crowd, since he was a short man.<sup>4</sup> So running ahead, he climbed up a sycamore tree to see Jesus, since he was about to pass that way.<sup>5</sup> When Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, hurry and come down because today it is necessary for me to stay at your house."<sup>6</sup> So he quickly came down and welcomed him joyfully.<sup>7</sup> All who saw it began to complain, "He's gone to stay with a sinful man."<sup>8</sup> But Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, "Look, I'll give half of my possessions to the poor, Lord. And if I have extorted anything from anyone, I'll pay back four times as much."<sup>9</sup> "Today salvation has come to this house," Jesus told him, "because he too is a son of Abraham."<sup>10</sup> For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save the lost."*

Today -

Matthew 5:33-34 (CSB) *But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you. [TODAY]  
<sup>34</sup> Therefore don't worry about tomorrow, because tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. [TOMORROW]*

Hebrews 9:27-28 (ESV) *And just as it is appointed for man to die once, [TODAY ENDS] and after that comes judgment [TOMORROW],*

Matthew 5:24 (CSB) *"Truly I tell you, anyone who hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not come under judgment but has passed from death to life.*

Matthew 7:21-23 <sup>21</sup>."Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup> On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, didn't we prophesy in your name, drive out demons in your name, and do many miracles in your name?' <sup>23</sup> Then I will announce to them, 'I never knew you. Depart from me, you lawbreakers!'

Hebrews 3:7-8a *Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today, if you hear His voice, <sup>8</sup>do not harden your hearts*
