Reignite - to give new life or energy to something.

Worship - the act of expressing reverence, adoration, and devotion.

Romans 12:1 (CSB) *Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship.*

How does a person do this?

I. Love the Lord God with all of you! **Matthew 22:37-40**

Psalms 100:1-5 (ESV) [Personal Worship] *Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth!*

² *Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into His presence with singing!*

[WHY] ³ *Know that the Lord, He is God! It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture.*

[Corporate Worship] ⁴ *Enter His gates with thanksgiving, and His courts with praise! Give thanks to Him; bless His name!*

[WHY] ⁵ *For the Lord is good; His steadfast love endures forever, and His faithfulness to all generations.*

1. GIVE GOD THE FIRST OF YOUR DAY.

Psalms 5:3 (CSB) *In the morning, Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I plead my case to you and watch expectantly.*

Mark 1:35 (CSB) *Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, He [Jesus] got up, went out, and made His way to a deserted place; and there He was praying.*

Acts 12:6-8

Start the FIRST of your day:

- a. Reading God's Word
- b. Thanking Him for your blessings
- c. Asking Him for:
 1. Strength (You will face temptations and challenges.)
 2. Guidance (You are going to make many decisions.)
 3. Courage (Put self aside and put Jesus first.)

Matthew 6:11 (CSB) *Give us today our daily bread.*

Exodus 16:4 (CSB) *Then the Lord said to Moses, "I am going to rain bread from heaven for you. The people are to go out each day and gather enough for that day. This way I will test them to see whether or not they will follow my instructions.*

2. GIVE GOD THE FIRST DAY OF YOUR WEEK

- Resurrection - On Sunday Pentecost - Always on a Sunday - Acts 2:1-4

3. GIVE GOD THE FIRST PART OF YOUR BLESSINGS.

Proverbs 3:9-10 (CSB) *Honor the Lord with your possessions and with the first produce of your entire harvest; ¹⁰then your barns will be completely filled, and your vats will overflow with new wine.*

Malachi 3:10-12 (NLT) *Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test! ¹¹Your crops will be abundant, for I will guard them from insects and disease. Your grapes will not fall from the vine before they are ripe," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies. ¹²"Then all nations will call you blessed, for your land will be such a delight," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies.*

II. Love Your neighbor. Be kind and INVITE!

John 1:46 (CSB) *"Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" Nathanael asked him. "Come and see," Philip answered.*

Matthew 11:28-30 (CSB) *Come to me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.*

John 4:28-30 (CSB) *Then the woman left her water jar, went into town, and told the people, ²⁹"Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?" ³⁰They left the town and made their way to Him.*
