A counterfeit god is anything so central and essential to your life that, should you lose it, your life would hardly feel worth living... An idol is whatever you look at and say, in your heart of hearts, 'If I have that, then I'll feel my life has meaning, then I'll know I have value, then I'll feel significant and secure.'" – Tim Keller 'Counterfeit Gods'
