"...You have given Him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom You have given Him. And this is eternal life, that they know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ _____." (v.2-3)

"I glorified You on earth, having accomplished the work that You gave me to do. And now, Father, glorify Me in Your own presence with _____ before the world existed." (v.4-5)

2. Jesus Prays for _____ (v.6-19)

"I have manifested Your name to the people whom You gave Me out of the world... I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for _____, for they are Yours." (v.6,9)



JESUS PRAYS THREE THINGS FOR THE DISCIPLES:

A. That they would be _____.

"And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to You Holy Father, _____... While I was with them, I kept them in Your name, which You have given Me. I have guarded them that not one of them has been lost, except the son of destruction that the Scripture might be fulfilled. (v.11-12)

"I have given them Your word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. I do not ask that You take them out of the world, but that You _____." (v.14-15)


