1. When You Can't Control Your Circumstances

WHAT SHOULD I REMEMBER WHILE I'M WAITING?

1. Remember God Rewards Patience

"Let us not get tired of doing what is right, for <u>after a while</u> we will reap <u>a harvest of blessing</u> IF we don't get discouraged and give up." Galatians 6:9

2. Remember God Rewards Stewardship

"The master was full of praise. Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been <u>faithful</u> in handling this <u>small amount</u>, so now I will give you many <u>more responsibilities</u>. Let's celebrate together! " <u>Matthew 25:21</u>

3. Remember This is Not the End of the Story
