THEY SAY THAT THE VALUE OF SOMETHING IS DETERMINED BY THE PRICE YOU ARE WILLING TO PAY FOR IT.

<u>John 3:16</u>- (NLT)"For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."

IN SOME OF JESUS TEACHING HE COMMUNICATES OUR VALUE.

<u>Matthew 6:26</u>- "Look at the birds. They don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren't you far more valuable to him than they are?"

You are more valuable than religion

Religious people will always value the law above the person.

Matthew 12:14- "Then the Pharisees called a meeting to plot how to kill Jesus."

The moment you and I devalue a person you become un-like Jesus Christ!

<u>Luke 15:20-24</u>- "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.'

"But his father said to the servants, 'Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet. And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast, for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found. 'So the party began."

Don't allow your mistakes to determine your value!

Please allow God to tell you how valuable you are to Him!

How about that spouse or children that continually communicated to you how worthless you are.

Please allow God to tell you how much He loves you and how valuable you are to Him!

<u>Matthew 13:45-46</u>- "Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant on the lookout for choice pearls. When he discovered a pearl of great value, he sold everything he owned and bought it!"

The common interpretation of these verses is that a person should be willing to part with everything in order to possess the Kingdom.

However, the meaning could be that Jesus is the purchaser who gave His all to secure the Kingdom so you and I could be part of it.
