Message: Does God hate non-Christians?
Scripture: 2 Peter 3:9, Matt 18:12-14, 2 Cor. 5:16-20, Col. 1:21-23, John 1:29

Get Started: What is the most common view you've heard about God's attitude toward those of other religions by people who aren't Christ-Followers?

Head: What Does God Want Me to Know?

(Orthodoxy – What does He want me to know: about God? about man? How can I think biblically about this topic?)

1. What do the Scriptures that Wayne preached on indicate about God's character?
2. Based on Wayne's sermon what would be your response to a non-Christian who asked if God hates them?

Heart: How/What Does God Want Me to Love/Feel?

(Orthocardia – Do I have the right attitude about what God says about this? What does He want to change in my heart or emotions? How do my deepest desires align with what this tells me? Do I even want to follow what He says about this?)

3. Consider people who you know who don't believe, how does your heart react to passages that make it clear that Jesus is the only way?
4. How do we in love communicate the truth of their position in God's eyes to someone who doesn't believe?

Hands: What Does God Want Me to Do?

(Orthopraxy – Do I take the right actions: how should I/we respond? What action(s) would show obedience?)

5. Individual: Based on this message, the text above and the discussion, what is God asking you to do differently? How will you respond?
6. Group: God often not only calls the individual to action, but He also calls upon the group to respond. How might your group respond together? What should your group do differently?
