## **Head: What Does God Want Me to Know?**

(Orthodoxy – What does He want me to know: about God? about man? How can I think biblically about this topic?)

- 1. Consider your own beliefs and actions, is there some place where you are unknowingly practicing deism or practical atheism (living, acting, speaking as if God did not exist)?
- 2. What makes our Trinitarian God unique among the plethora of other theisms?

## Heart: What/How Does God Want Me to Love?

(Orthocardia – Do I have the right heart? What does He want to change in my emotions? How do my deepest desires align with what this tells me? Do I even want to follow what He is saying?)

- 3. How do we love the Lord with all our heart? What does that practically look like?
- 4. Fleming Rutledge said, "The witness of the Bible is that every other god under the son is a product of human consciousness except the God of the Old and New Testaments". What can we do to love this God more?

## Hands: What Does God Want Me to Do?

(Orthopraxy – the right actions: how should I/we respond? what action(s) would show obedience?)

- 5. Individual: Based on this message, the text above and the discussion, what is God asking you to do differently? How will you respond?
- 6. Group: God often not only calls the individual to action, but He also calls upon the group to respond. How might your group respond together? What should your group do differently?
