2nd Timothy 3:1-5

1 But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days.
2 People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy,
3 without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, **4** treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God— **5** having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people.

Jesus from John 17:15-20

15 My prayer is not that you take them out of the *WORLD* but that you *PROTECT THEM* from the evil one. **16** They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. **17** *SANCTIFY* (set apart) them by the *TRUTH*; your *WORD IS TRUTH*. **18** As you sent me into the world, I *HAVE SENT THEM* into the world. **19** For them I *SANCTIFY* myself, that they too may be truly *SANCTIFIED*. **20** “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those *WHO WILL BELIEVE IN ME THROUGH THEIR MESSAGE*.”
