

14 What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them?


15 Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food.

Cognitive belief is not enough. Your belief must go deep enough to translate into action. Demons “know” more than us, but still don’t obey. Don’t aspire to be like a demon.

James 2:20-24






