Response of Children

Obey - "to listen under."

- Obedience to one's parents is limited to everything that is compatible with our primary loyalty who is the Lord Jesus Christ.
- The limitation of being under a parent's authority is determined by one's culture.

<u>Honor</u> – respect for their provision, perspective and position.

Practical reason - It ensures the fullness of God's blessing.

Response of Parents

Negative exhortation – "Do not provoke..."

<u>Provoke</u> – "resentment of actions and attitudes inconsistent with one's faith commitments."

- Positive exhortation "...bring them up..."
- 1. "bring them up" —to nourish or feed.
- 2. "discipline" is corrective towards right living.
- 3. "instruction" teach God's law into their context.

Final Thoughts

- Your life is speaking far louder to your children than anything you are saying.
- ❖ Model for your children what it looks like to depend on Jesus and respond honestly and humbly when you don't.
