The Post-Flood Assessment

1. Humanity's need for God's grace is the same.
 - a) Noah's response in worship with "burnt offerings."
 - b) God's rationale for His promise to never curse the ground again is the total depravity of man.
2. The promise of the "seed of the woman" is still moving towards completion.

Life in a Post-Flood World

1. Sin makes everything God intends more difficult.
2. Sin changes all our relationships.
3. Sin devalues and destroys what God values.
 - a) We are all "connected" by our humanity. (vs. 5)
 - b) We all matter to God as His image bearers. (vs. 6)
4. Sin will be judged one final time.
