

### *Three Interpretation Principles*

❖ The Principle of Harmony

God cannot contradict Himself so we can expect His word to possess an underlying consistency.

❖ The Principle of History

Every word of God was spoken in a cultural or historical context.

❖ The Principle of Cultural Transposition

How does the teaching in a text transfer to a different place or context?

### *Two Instructions*

- 1) It is a woman's responsibility to become a student of God's word.
  - a) "quietly" – refers to a "gentle demeanor" as opposed to one that is combative, disruptive and even disrespectful.
  - b) "with all submissiveness" – refers to yielding to authority.
- 2) A woman is not permitted to participate in the authoritative proclamation of God's word in public worship.
  - ❖ "teach" – the context refers to the explanation of Scripture in the official teaching of sound doctrine.

### *Final Thought*

- ❖ The biblical basis for equality is the fact that we are created in the image of God. It is not the roles and responsibilities God has given to men and women.
