The Purpose

- ❖ Cain chooses and pursues a life of self-sufficiency and self-preservation.
 - a) He brings an offering for worship on his terms.
 - b) He rejects the obligations of family life.

-The word “brother” is emphasizing a mutual obligation and responsibility to care for one another.

God Responds

1. The ground will no longer produce for Cain.
2. Cain will never find rest.
 - Always searching – never finding
 - Always wandering – never home
 - Always haunted by fear – never at peace
3. Cain will face God’s justice.

Questions for Reflection

- ❖ Does God’s response to Cain’s rebellion seem unreasonably gracious to you?
- ❖ How serious do you take God’s warning regarding the reality of the “unsuspecting power of sin” in this life?
- ❖ Are you choosing vengeance rather than forgiveness towards someone in your life?
